SUBJECT: Conejo Senior Volunteer Program (CSVP) Activity Report: July - September 2025

HIGHLIGHTS

CSVP Local Partner Agencies

CSVP continues to cultivate meaningful volunteer opportunities with local nonprofits. In August, CSVP partnered with Safe Passage Youth Foundation for their Shop with a Youth event, where 20 youth received a \$200 back-to-school shopping spree. Safe Passage requested bilingual (preferred, not required) volunteers to assist youth and their parents with shopping. Six CSVP volunteers participated, and feedback from both the organization and volunteers reflected a highly successful and rewarding experience.

In September, a handful of CSVP volunteers attended an orientation at the Stagecoach Inn Museum and began Hospice of the Conejo training. These sessions introduced volunteers to unique service opportunities - supporting individuals and families through Hospice of the Conejo's compassionate respite and "No One Dies Alone" programs, and helping preserve local history through docent tours, event planning, and museum operations at the Stagecoach Inn.

In addition, CSVP sent 15 volunteers to assist the Conejo Free Clinic with assembling 1,100 medical and dental outreach kits for local farmworkers and immigrant families. These kits are part of an ongoing community outreach effort, and volunteers played an important role in helping prepare and organize supplies for distribution.

Senior Nutrition Lunch Program (SNP)

During this period, the Senior Nutrition Program, administered by CSVP, served 5,855 meals to seniors aged 60+. Supported by 27 dedicated volunteers, the program operates Monday - Friday from 11:30am to 1:00pm at the Goebel Café. In May, the SNP extended its hours of operation, resulting in a notable increase in participation and providing more seniors with the opportunity to enjoy nutritious meals and social engagement.
