HIGHLIGHTS

CSVP Local Partner Agencies

Hospice of the Conejo - In October, CSVP placed 8 volunteers into Hospice of the Conejo's new volunteer training program, preparing them to provide compassionate, non-medical support and companionship to individuals and families facing life-limiting illness.

Many Mansions Bowls of Hope

CSVP supported Many Mansions' annual Bowls of Hope event by recruiting volunteers to assist with event setup, guest check-in, activities, food service, and event logistics. Volunteers played a key role in the success of this community fundraiser supporting affordable housing and supportive services.

America Supporting Americans (ASA)

CSVP partnered with ASA to support a Card Signing & Donation Drive held at the Goebel Adult Center. Volunteers and patrons participated in writing cards and assembling donations to be sent to active-duty service members overseas.

Seasonal Events

CSVP volunteers also volunteered at Cancer Support Communities Pumpkin Succulent Social, Turkey Dash Day at CLU Memorial Field, Thanksgiving luncheon for low-income seniors, Harbor House meal program, and more!

Senior Nutrition Lunch Program (SNP)

During this period, the Senior Nutrition Program, administered by CSVP, served 5,772 meals to seniors aged 60+. Supported by 27 dedicated volunteers, the program operates Monday - Friday from 11:30am to 1:00pm at the Goebel Café. In May, the SNP extended its hours of operation, resulting in a notable increase in participation and providing more seniors with the opportunity to enjoy nutritious meals and social engagement.

CSVP Donations

The Teddy Bears Workshop, a CSVP group of 27 volunteers, meets every Monday afternoon at the Goebel Center where the group handmakes 25 bears per week. Each bear is one-of-a-kind. They volunteered a combined 545 hours during this period. This past December, CSVP donated 373 bears to seven Title 1 Kindergarten classes.
