SUBJECT: Conejo Senior Volunteer Program (CSVP) Activity Report: January – March 2024

HIGHLIGHTS

Wellness Fest

The CSVP Wellness event took place Wednesday, January 17th. We were joined by 34 local businesses, 25 nonprofit agencies, and 7 divisions from the City of Thousand Oaks. 500+ people attended this event and 40+ volunteers and staff helped make this event successful. CSVP handed out 300 lunches to patrons and the Goebel Center Chef provided 200 lunches to vendors and volunteers. The Fest raised \$12,000 in revenue for CRPD.

Goebel Café Breakfast

Breakfast is served Monday - Friday, 9:00-11:00am at the Goebel Café. During this period, the Café brought in \$4,718 in revenue.

Senior Nutrition Lunch Program

During this period, the Senior Nutrition Program, administered by CSVP, served 4,812 meals to seniors aged 60+. Twenty-five volunteers help to run this program held Monday-Friday, 11:30am-12:30pm at the Goebel Café.

CSVP Local Partner Agencies

CSVP offered two new Volunteer Information Sessions at the Goebel Center in March. One was to learn more about volunteering with the Boys & Girls Club in many capacities including helping young people develop academic, behavioral, and social skills through homework completion, helping to cover topics such as energy, electricity, and science, engaging youth in financial decision making through interactive tools and games, and helping to inspire creativity and skill development in visual, digital, and performing arts. 10 potential volunteers joined us for this meeting. The second session was to learn about volunteering with Harbor House in helping connect with local low-income seniors in need of community resources. They are looking for some caring volunteers to join them in performing outreach to these vulnerable seniors. 22 potential volunteers joined us at this session.
