8. ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION- Commission Concerns/Comments

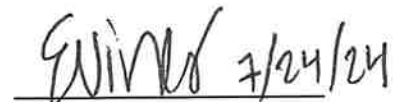

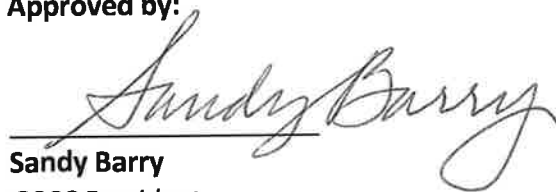
