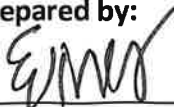

It was moved by Dunbar, and seconded by Martinich, as there was no further business, the meeting was adjourned at approximately 1:25pm.

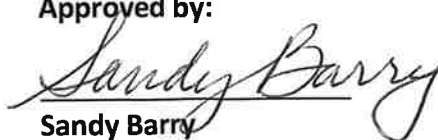
