RECRUITMENT ANNOUNCEMENT • The Goebel Senior Center Commission (GSCC) is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit community service organization that works in collaboration with the staff of the Goebel Adult Community Center (GACC) to support older adults through recreation programs & activities, community connections, and social services. As a Goebel Senior Center Commissioner, some primary objectives include:

1. Volunteering time and sharing unique skills,
2. Assisting in the development, marketing, and execution of recreation events and activities,
3. Allocating funds for facility upgrades, equipment, program budgets, and other GACC services that benefit older adults,
4. Establishing priorities and coordinating use of the GACC, in accordance with the City of Thousand Oaks and the Conejo Recreation & Park District (CRPD),
5. Conducting research through surveys, questionnaires, interviews and/or other means to evaluate the effectiveness of the GACC and associated programs,
6. Recommends and coordinates plans to meet identified needs at the GACC.

CRITERIA • Goebel Senior Center Commissioners must:

- Be 50 years of age or older,
- Reside within the boundaries of Conejo Recreation & Park District,
- Attend GSCC meetings on the fourth Wednesday of each month,
- Commit to a minimum of 15 volunteer hours monthly at the GACC.

A tentative calendar showing scheduled events and meetings will be provided at the initial interview for each candidate to assess his or her ability to meet the time commitment. Regular GSCC meetings are open to the public and held on the fourth Wednesday of each month. Potential candidates are encouraged to attend and observe at least once.

HOW TO APPLY • **Beginning January 5th, 2026**, interested applicants may pick up an application, available at the Goebel Adult Center and online by visiting www.crpdpd.org/gacc. **Completed GSCC applications should be submitted via e-mail to: evines@crpd.org or hand delivered to the Goebel Adult Center, attention Administrative Assistant, Emily Vines, no later than 5:00pm on Friday, February, 27th, 2026.**

THE APPOINTMENT PROCESS • A panel composed of three current Goebel Senior Center Commissions will interview and consider individuals who apply for appointment or reappointment to the GSCC. Recommendations will then be made to the CRPD Board of Directors for final confirmation. **Please Note: Commissioners appointed will be required to file State Law Conflict of Interest Code, California Fair Political Practices Commission (FPPC) Form 700 Statement of Economic Interests.**
