**SUBJECT:** Appointments to the Goebel Senior Center Commission

## RECOMMENDATION

Approve the reappointments of Cynthia Bengston, Maxine Cleary, Nancy Healey, Lisa Thorsen, and Mickey Toyen to the Goebel Senior Center Commission.

## DISCUSSION

The Goebel Senior Center Commission is a non-profit community service organization that serves under the Conejo Recreation and Park District Board of Directors; it includes up to 15 members and in accordance with its bylaws, holds annual elections. Commission terms are typically three years with five terms up for election each year.

Five members whose terms are due to expire on June 30, 2026; Cynthia Bengston, Maxine Cleary, Nancy Healey, Lisa Thorsen, and Mickey Toyen, applied for reappointment. In addition to the five members who reapplied, applications were received from two additional applicants for a total of seven. Applications for those nominated for Board appointments are attached.

In advance of the election, interviews were held with applicants on April 1, by the Applicant Review Ad Hoc Committee made up of Commissioners Sandy Barry, Dorothy Hatfield, and Mindy Rosiejka. Director Huffer observed the interview process. As a result of the interviews, the Applicant Review Ad Hoc Committee made recommendations to the Commission.

At the April 22 meeting of the Goebel Senior Center Commission, the annual election was conducted, and five applicants were recommended to serve on the Commission. All five seats are three-year terms, effective July 1, 2026. The results of the election (those that received majority votes) are as follows: Cynthia Bengston, Maxine Cleary, Nancy Healey, Lisa Thorsen, and Mickey Toyen.
