The Therapeutic Recreation Unit is committed to providing fun and healthy, social, educational, and recreational opportunities, in a safe and welcoming environment.

Please assist us in honoring this commitment by following our established Code of Conduct.

- Please show respect for staff, instructors, volunteers, the public, other program participants, and yourself, at all times.
- Please show respect for program equipment, supplies, and facilities.
- Please use appropriate language and gestures.
 - Bullying; threatening; intimidating; or aggressive verbal or physical behavior toward others is not acceptable and may be grounds for immediate suspension.
- Please stay within the designated program area unless you have permission to go elsewhere or have signed out from the program.
- Personal cell phones must be used in a way that does not disrupt the program or infringe on the privacy of others.

Please remember that attendance to Therapeutic Recreation programs is a privilege. Failure to follow these rules may result in consequences, to include:

- Staff may decide to notify a parent, guardian or conservator and request that the participant be picked up immediately, or may request that a nonconserved adult leave the program immediately.
- The participant may be placed on suspension or expulsion from Therapeutic Recreation programs, facilities and grounds.
