1. What are the program options for QuaranTeam?

We are offering a 5-Day program (M-F), 3-Day program (M/W/F), and a 2-Day program (T/Th)

2. Where will the childcare take place?

Our programs will be held primarily at the community centers listed below. However, we may utilize other facilities as necessary.

3. Are you offering a full-day option?

At this time we are not able to offer a full-day of care.

4. Will there be scholarships available?
