Youth & Adult Classes, Camps, and Programs

Indoor Programs

Masks are required in all public indoor spaces regardless of vaccination status. Face
coverings must be worn over the mouth and nose in all indoor public setting, venues,
gatherings, and workplaces, including but not limited to offices, retail stores, restaurants
and bars, theaters, family entertainment centers, conference and event centers, and
government offices serving the public.

Outdoor Programs

Individuals are not required to wear a mask outdoors, even if they cannot maintain
physical distancing. However, per CDC recommendations, in areas of substantial to high
transmission, people who are not fully vaccinated are encouraged to wear a mask in
crowded outdoor settings or during activities that involve sustained close contact with
people who are not fully vaccinated.
