For 51 years, the Conejo Senior Volunteer Program (CSVP) has provided meaningful opportunities in the Conejo Valley for adults 55+. Nine hundred CSVP volunteers generally work 180,000 hours at places such as Adult Literacy, Hospice of the Conejo, and the Stagecoach Inn Museum.

These hours of meaningful community engagement provide physical and mental stimulation which as been proven to be essential for maintaining health and wellness in retirement. Furthermore, Independent Sector research estimates these hours of volunteer work to be valued at over \$5,000,000 in human resource contributions.

This creates a trifecta of benefits as senior volunteers stay active and engaged while helping local partner agencies to better serve the community.
