For 52 years, the Conejo Senior Volunteer Program (CSVP) has provided meaningful opportunities in the Conejo Valley for adults 55+. 800 CSVP volunteers work 180,000 hours per year at places such as Conejo Valley Village (CVV), Hospice of the Conejo, the Stagecoach Inn Museum, Senior Concerns, and School on Wheels.

These hours of meaningful community engagement provide physical and mental stimulation which has been proven to be essential for maintaining health and wellness in retirement. Furthermore, Independent Sector research estimates these hours of volunteer work to be valued at over \$5,000,000 in human resource contributions.

This creates a trifecta of benefits as senior volunteers stay active and engaged while helping local partner agencies to better serve the community.
